SECURITIES

For a gift of appreciated stock, bonds, or mutual fund shares held for more than one year, donors can obtain a charitable gift deduction for the full market value and avoid capital gains tax.

IMPORTANT: If you would like to receive a tax receipt, please instruct your broker to share your name and address with LLS at the time of transfer.

Mutual Funds: To initiate the process, please ask your broker to contact Joan Coprio at **914-821-8414** or Joan.Coprio@lls.org. She will help coordinate the request to Wells Fargo for a Shell/Bin Account Number (the special-delivery instructions for the gift). Wells Fargo requires up to five business days to generate the Shell/Bin Number. When the information from Wells Fargo is received, the broker will be able to complete the transfer at that time.

Please note that transfers of mutual funds require several business days to complete, and up to 10 business days at year-end.
